VILLAGE NEWS:

The Village would like to inform residents that Russland Road, from Old State Road to Walnut Hill Drive, will be oiled and chipped on Tuesday August 30th. This portion of the road needs this layer of oil and chip to seal the asphalt that was put down a couple of weeks ago and will complete this road project. This work will begin at 9am and should be complete by 11am so as to not interrupt morning school traffic.

The Village Hall offices will be closed Monday September 5th in observance of Labor Day.

Large trash pick up will be on Thursday September 22nd. Please have all items separated from your regular garbage and at the curb by 6:00 a.m. Items that will not be taken include:

-anything containing oil or antifreeze (unless it is drained), tires, car parts, paint or varnish cans unless paint/varnish is dried out, no hazardous substances.
