VILLAGE NEWS:

The Village would like to remind residents to that we will be flushing hydrants the week of October 17th – 21st. Please be cautious when doing laundry.

Allied Waste has contacted the Village regarding yard waste mixed with regular trash. It is against EPA laws to put yard waste in with garbage. Please be aware that Allied Waste's drivers have been informed to tag and leave any containers/bags with yard waste included.

This is also a reminder that the Village has an area by the sewer plant to dispose of yard waste. It is asked that you dispose of your yard waste in the designated areas. This area is under video surveillance at all times!

Please remember the Village does not permit ANY leaf burning. This fall the Village will offer leaf pick-up for those who cannot dispose of their leaves. Leaves will be picked up only when the following is complied with: leaves are put in yard bags (these are available at Aviston Lumber, Walmart, etc.), and a message is left at the Village Shed (228-7361) with your name and address. Please allow 2 business days for us to pick-up. If you have any questions, please call our office at 228-7262.

Please refrain from blowing grass and leaves onto the street or curb as this restricts water flow into the drains.
